SUPERVISING CLUB MEMBERS

QUESTIONS TO CONSIDER

- What activities do you have planned today?
- How are you structuring your activities? (Warm-up, game rules and expectations, activity, cool-down, etc.)
- How will you hold the group accountable to your expectations during activities?
- How are you planning to stay involved in your activities, but still position yourself properly and lead your group?
- How will you listen to your Club members needs during activities?
- How will you adjust if your activity isn't going well? What is plan B and C?
- What behaviors do you want to model for Club members today? (Be vocal, use encouragement, recognize who is doing well, have fun, etc.)
- What scenarios might you encounter where you will need to use behavior management strategies?
- How will you address behavioral issues while still supervising?
- What is your plan to respond if someone is injured in your program area? How will you still supervise the group?
- How will you communicate and request support without leaving your group during activities?
- How will you adjust your plans if you are short staffed?
 - o Will your high-risk areas still be well covered?
 - o Does your emergency action plan change?
 - Do you need to minimize the number of program areas available?
 - Do you need to change the number of activities available?
