## SWIM CHECK POLICY AND WRISTBANDS

Green Swim Band Expectations - May go anywhere in the pool
☐ Tread water for one (1) minute with ears and face above the water.
☐ Jump into water that is over the individual's head and return to the surface.
Swim the length of the pool unassisted using front crawl or breaststroke with confident breaths.
☐ Exit the pool without assistance.
Yellow Swim Band Expectations - Unless meets Green Expectations
☐ See below age expectations.
Must stand comfortably, at armpit level and flat footed, in the entire shallow water swim zone. Please see lifeguard to get measured for height requirement.
☐ May not enter deep water swim zone.
Red Swim Band Expectations - Unless meets Green or Yellow Expectations
□ 0-6 years old.
■ Must be within arm's reach in the water of an active parent/caregiver at all times.
Unable to meet the Green or Yellow wristband requirements.

## **NOTES FOR PARENTS:**

- Children 6 and under must be accompanied by a parent/caregiver at least 16 years of age in the water unless they are able to pass the YMCA Swim Check. Children who pass the swim check must still have a parent/caregiver in the pool area.
- Children 7-12 years old may be in the water unaccompanied if they are able to stand comfortably in the swim zone OR pass the swim check, but a parent must remain at the facility. Please check in with the lifeguards and let them know where you will be.
- Children 13 and up may be in the pool and facility unaccompanied.
- If there are two children for one adult in the water, one child will be asked to wear a lifejacket, unless one child can pass the swim check expectations.
- Lifejackets are available for non-swimmers. If worn, the swimmer must be within arm's reach of an active guardian in the water at all times.
- Enjoy your time at the pool!
